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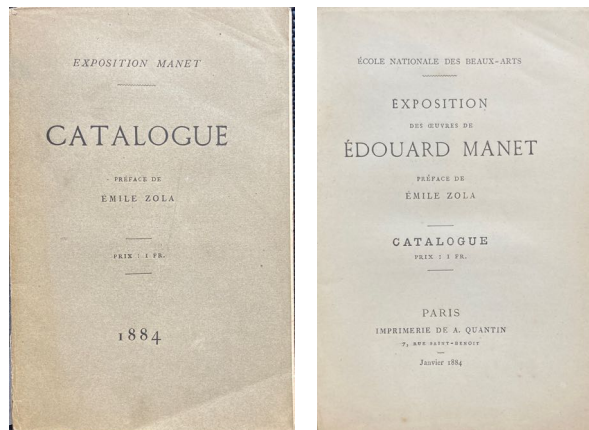

First edition: catalog of the first retrospective exhibition devoted to Édouard Manet, held at the École Nationale des Beaux Arts in Paris.

The catalog begins with a warm and superb 23-page preface by Émile Zola, Manet's close friend, praising “cet homme de scandale, si longtemps nié, et dont l'influence est aujourd'hui dominante. [...] Le temps achèvera de la classer parmi les grands ouvriers de ce siècle, qui ont donné leur vie au triomphe du vrai”.

The list of the 179 exhibited items is followed by the “Discours prononcé par M. Antonin Proust sur la tombe de Manet”—the artist died in April 1883 and was buried in the Passy Cemetery. The list of the members of the “Comité de l'exposition” includes Edmond Bazire, Philippe Burty, Durand-Ruel, A. Guillemet, Alfred Stevens, Théodore Duret, etc. A fine copy.
